WINNIPEG FRINGE FESTIVAL

Merlyn Productions Theatre Company will present "MING LEE AND THE MAGIC TREE", a play for young people by AURAND HARRIS, at the 2013 Winnipeg Fringe Theatre Festival, July 17 to 28!



In this delightful tale of the Far East, a prince who wishes to marry the Princess of the Stars must remain a tiger until he learns what makes a happy man. Ming Lee, a poor stone cutter, believes wealth and power will bring him joy. Together they discover the true meaning of happiness - and that "a fine hat does not make a fine head"!

Staged in the classic Chinese style with a storyteller Chorus and comical Property Man, this will be a fun and unique theatrical experience for the whole family!

Directing the play is Merlyn Productions Artistic Director JOHN CHASE.

"Ming Lee and The Magic Tree" was last staged locally by Fantasy Theatre for Children at the 1993 Winnipeg Fringe Festival, as directed by TONY FROST, with Merlyn Productions director JOHN CHASE amongst its cast.

The classic format of Chinese theatre in which "Ming Lee" is presented – featuring Chorus, Property Man, Orchestra and Most Honourable Actors – first appeared on Western stages one hundred years ago in 1912/13, when it was adapted by GEORGE C. HAZELTON and BENRIMO for a play entitled "The Yellow Jacket" at the Fulton Theatre.

In this special 2013 presentation, we are immensely pleased to bring you both a 20^{th} anniversary revival at the Winnipeg Fringe Festival, and a centennial celebration of classic Chinese theatre on the Western stage!
